



Greg Johnson started a regulatory consulting practice six years ago after 14 years of construction industry experience as an installer and contractor; more than 16 years of local government building inspection experience; and nearly 17 years of non-profit association board experience including 1 year on the board of directors of the International Conference of Building Officials; 1 year on the board of directors of the International Accreditation Service; and 7 years on the board of directors of the International Conference of the International Conference.

In the course of his career Greg has served on numerous codes and standards related committees.
