Jay Peters Codes and Standards International (CSI)

Jay Peters: 40 years in the plumbing and mechanical industry as a tradesman, contractor, executive director of plumbing, mechanical and fuel gas for the International Code Council (ICC) and senior director of codes and education for the International Association of Plumbing and Mechanical Officials (IAPMO). Currently, he is the principal advisor and an expert witness at Codes and Standards International — assisting governments, manufacturers, associations and industry stakeholders impacted by plumbing and HVACR standards, codes, product certification and global regulatory issues.

He has presented and met with international leaders in Laos, South Africa, Soweto, Philippines, China, Haiti, Colombia, Mexico, England, Scotland, Switzerland, Puerto Rico, the Caribbean and Japan in an effort to improve health and provide access to sanitation for those in need. In 2011 he was inducted into the World Toilet Organization Hall of Fame for his contributions to the global sanitation movement and for pioneering and initiating the official launch of the United Nations International Year of Sanitation in 2008. His current projects include helping officials in China to standardize construction for President Xi's toilet revolution and collaborating with USAID in Haiti to raise the standards of the plumbing industry by adapting and adopting plumbing codes, improving education and creating a certification program for plumbing installers.
