He managed the organization's national and international communications programs, press relations and served as chief spokesperson. Brown gained international recognition while serving as a public relations representative in Saudi Arabia to several private sector companies while working for a Saudi public relations agency.

He also has extensive experience in the private sector, working as an internal communications specialist for Exxon Company USA.
