Scholarships available for two-day classroom training event

Registration and course selection is now open for the National Volunteer Fire Council's (NVFC) Training Summit. The Summit will take place Friday, June 20, from 8:30am-4:30pm and Saturday, June 21, from 8am-noon in Myrtle Beach, SC. The conference is open to all volunteer firefighters, EMTs, department leadership, and other fire department personnel and Fire Corps members from across the United States.
