## Investigation Protocol for Fires Determined to Have Been Caused by Cigarette

- Goal: To determine if a cigarette was, or was not, complaint with NYS law for fire-safe cigarettes.
- **Implement:** Use the following protocol for all fires where a cigarette may be initially suspected to have to been involved in the ignition of the fire.
  - 1. Determine origin of the fire.
  - Determine if a cigarette is a possible cause of the fire If "Yes"...use this protocol If "No"... disregard this protocol
  - 3. Physical Evidence
    - a. Determine if there is evidence of a cigarette at the point of origin.
    - b. Determine if there are cigarettes or cigarette packaging in the room of origin.
    - c. Determine if there are ashtrays or containers for cigarettes inside or outside the building.
    - d. Determine if there are cigarettes in the vehicles(s) of building occupants.
    - e. Determine if building occupants have cigarettes on their person.
    - f. Identify brand-styles of cigarette.
    - g. Refer information to OFPC using a <u>Report of Suspected Cigarette Caused Fire</u>
  - 4. Interviews
    - a. Determine how many smokers used the room of origin.
    - b. Determine brand-style preference and brand loyalty of smokers.
    - c. Determine where cigarettes were purchased.
    - d. Refer information to OFPC.
